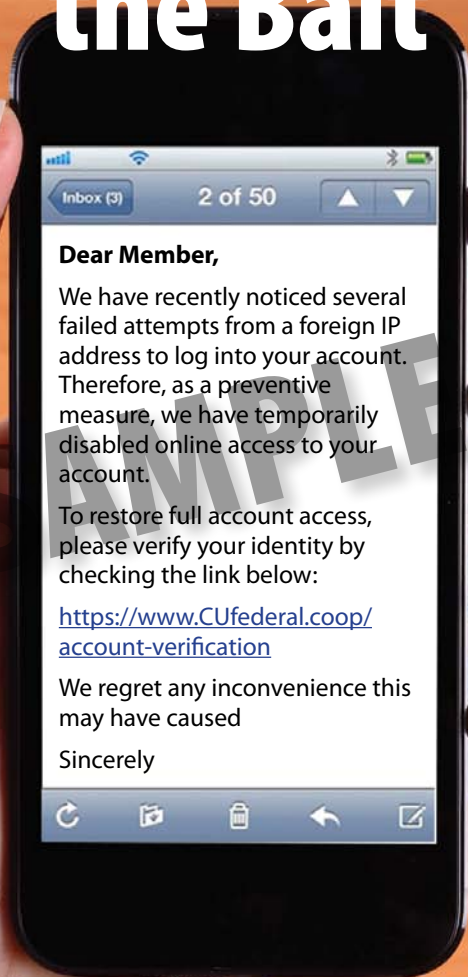

Phishers use spam—unwanted e-mail—to lure people into fake websites to obtain personal information and commit identity theft.

Victims receive fraudulent e-mails containing authentic-looking logos and familiar graphics. You're asked to reveal account information or other personal data such as usernames, passwords, and Social Security numbers.

Your credit union will never send you an e-mail—or call you by phone—asking for personal data. We already have this information.
